The PJ Library encourages literacy and piques interest in Jewish values from a young age by introducing children to Jewish culture and tradition through stories and songs. PJ Library recipients, from the age of six months to six years, receive monthly mailings of a high-quality children's book or CD. PJ Library helps to nurture Jewish life and strengthen families and their relationship to the Jewish community.

Jewish Eldercare of Rhode Island (JERI) is an outreach program that trains volunteers to become visitors to the elderly in our Jewish community. With regular visits to hospitals, nursing homes and assisted living facilities, volunteers continue our traditions through Shabbat services, Passover Seders and other holiday activities. Introducing elder care facilities' staff to Jewish observances, traditions and dietary customs is important so that they can be more responsive to the needs of their Jewish residents.

IF YOU COULD, WOULD YOU HELP SHAPE A YOUNG ADULT'S JEWISH PERSPECTIVE?

The Brown University/Rhode Island School of Design and the University of Rhode Island Hillel programs create a social, cultural and spiritual connection to the students' Judaism while cultivating personal development through self-reflection and expression. The Alef List was created to gather young professionals and graduate students post-college, as they enter the next phase of their adult lives. Through a variety of social and networking events, young Jewish professionals strengthen their ties to each other and to their Judaism.

200 Hillel events reach over 1000 Jewish college students annually while 50 Jewish young adults in Rhode Island have networked through the Alef List during its first three events.

OPPRESSED JEWISH PERSON OR FAMILY DISCOVER THEIR JEWISH HERITAGE?

The Limmud-Keshet Conference helps Jews of all backgrounds realize their Jewish identities. This international conference of Jewish learning and culture celebrates the richness and multi-dimensional nature of Judaism. Bringing Jewish people together, including those whose lives were formerly oppressed without religious freedom, is one of Limmud-Keshet's greatest purposes. Last year over 450 people from all over Poland attended this important conference.

The Kesher program grew out of community need and a commitment to provide social services to Jews through their congregations. Kesher provides participating synagogues with a weekly, on-site social worker to help congregants with crisis intervention, short-term counseling and more. Kesher also reflects the sanctity of the synagogue and its commitment to the emotional, spiritual, and physical well-being of its congregants.

Here at home, Camp JORI, the only Jewish overnight camp in Rhode Island, strives to develop a community of respect and cooperation through Jewish culture and friendship.
